


# HOW TO INSTALL VENETIAN BLINDS | TIMBER & VISION WOOD



## Items Checklist

- 2 screws per brackets
- Venetian Blind
- Valance (& Returns for face mount blinds)
- Left & Right Bracket
- Central Bracket(s) - Amount varies depending on blind width

## Tools Required

- Cordless Drill with Philips head drill bit
- Metal Tape Measure

It is important to securely attach the brackets to the mounting surface. To achieve this the included screws must secure into wood studs, otherwise a fastener is required for secure mounting (not included).




We recommend the use of the Ramset 10mm Grip Hollow Wall Anchor	Pre-drill holes and use the included screws	Use a masonry drill and appropriate plugs, anchors or screws

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### 1. Position

As per your order, determine where you blind is to be fitted

- RECESS FIT - Inside your window frame
- FACE FIT - on the window frame or wall



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### 2. Installing Brackets

a) Place the corresponding end brackets in place. The LHS (Left Hand Side) bracket on the left hand side and the RHS (Right Hand Side) bracket on the right hand side.

**Note:** that the end brackets are etched with LHS or RHS.

b) Ensure the end brackets are fitted to the width you originally measured for your order (e.g. the edge of the architrave if you have measured correctly for a face fit).

c) Keeping the end brackets open, mark if necessary and pre drill 2 holes. After drilling holes, secure the brackets with the screws included. (Wood screws have been provided, however screws suitable for gyprock or brick walls may need to be purchased)

d) Space out central brackets evenly ensuring there is a bracket at least every 900mm and that all brackets are even.

e) Ensure the end brackets are fitted to the width you originally measured for your order (e.g. the edge of the architrave if you have measured correctly for a face fit).

**HANDY TIP:** Use the edges of your architrave as a reference point to keep the brackets level

### 3. Positioning The Blind

Slide the head rail into the brackets and close the brackets to secure the blind

### 4. Attaching The Valance

Recess Fit blinds will only have a fascia valance, where the Face Fit blinds will also include two side returns for the valance.

a) For Face Fit, attach the return to the fascia using the clips on the reverse of the fascia

b) For both Face Fit & Recess Fit, the valance can then be clipped onto the head rail of the blind via the hooks on the reverse of the valance.

### Child Safety

All blinds are supplied with Child Safety devices. It is the responsibility of the person installing the blinds to make sure these are installed and that warning tags are to remain on the blinds.



## WARNING CHILD SAFETY WITH LOOPED CORDS, CHAINS & BEAD CORDS

Young children can strangle in the loop of pull cords, chain and bead cords, and cords that run through window coverings. They can also wrap cords around their necks. To avoid strangulation, keep cords out of the reach of young children. Also,

1. Install safety devices that remove the cord loop or reduce access to cords, and
2. Move cots and furniture away from window covering cords.

The tension device reduces the hazards of strangulation or entanglement by limited access to the cord or bead chain. Anchor the device with the cord or bead chain to the wall or floor so young children cannot pull the cord or bead chain around their necks. Always keep cords out of the reach of young children.

**WARNING REGARDING CLEATS:** Cleats should be mounted at a sufficient height, so as to keep cords out of reach of young children. Cords must be fully wrapped around the cleat at all times. Always keep out of the reach of young children.

**WARNING FOR CORD RELEASE DEVICE:** This cord release device reduces the strangulation hazard in the pull cord by removing the permanent loop. The cords should not be tied together and the cords should not be twisted around each other when the device is assembled. This device will not prevent strangulation if young children wrap pull cords around their necks. Always keep cords out of reach of young children.
